Training to be an Observer requires commitment on your part. Observer training fits in with our regular observed rides. Training sessions are onroad with an associate and your Observer mentor. There are also additional classroom and practical sessions provided during the course that you should attend.

In order that the Group can make this work RAMG expect you to commit to a training plan and to give your mentor reasonable notice if you cannot attend a training session.

All of us have family or other commitments, which may understandably take priority. All we ask is that you plan so your Observer training is carried out efficiently.

Once you have qualified as a Local Observer, RAMG expect you to make a reasonable effort to observe at fortnightly observed rides in addition to any arranged with your Associate(s) at other times.
